Band Meeting and Election of 2010-11 Board of Directors

August 3, 2010

The Lake City Stinger Band held a Band Meeting at 8:30 p.m. following rehearsal on August 3, 2010. Twenty-five band members were present, along with Mike Pearce, Director. The purpose of the meeting was receive a Treasurer's report, elect the 2010-11 Board of Directors and discuss general operation of the band.

Bob Matthews called the meeting to order. George Hoffman discussed the financial position of the band. Checking account balance is \$1,740 with no outstanding invoices. Paid-up band membership is 18 so far this year. George asked those that have not joined to please do so. The band will request funding again this year from the Lake Fork Foundation and the Pioneer Jubilee Women's Club.

Bob thanked Joe Steele for his service on the Board the last two years. Bob presented the following slate of members who have agreed to serve on the Board for 2010-11: Jay Farrar, George Hoffman, Bob Matthews, Martha Reyburn and Karen Thormalen. Bob asked for nominations from the floor. There were none. Claire Jessee moved and Todd Mahlin seconded a motion that the nominees be elected by acclamation; motion carried unanimously by voice vote.

Charles Ferris asked how the \$20.00 annual dues amount was determined. Bob responded that this amount was considered affordable by most everyone. Jim Gibson indicated the dues in the Montrose Band were \$25.00. Of concern to most band members is our cramped rehearsal space, but no apparent solution exists at this point. Kerry Coy asked how best to recruit new members. Mike Pearce solicits new members at each concert, and everyone is encouraged to do the same.
